RESOLUTIONS

Requesting the Congress of the United States to provide for Federal Compliance with State Daylight-saving Laws.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts
2 hereby expresses its hope and expectation that congress
3 will enact such legislation as may be necessary to procure
4 federal compliance with daylight saving laws in those
5 states which have already passed or shall hereafter pass
6 such laws for local governance, and that the hours ob-
7 served by federal courts, by the post offices and mail
8 service, by internal revenue offices, and by all other fed-
9 eral functions in the said states will be the hours estab-
10 lished by local legislation; and, be it further

11 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be sent by
12 the secretary of the commonwealth to the presiding of-
13 ficers of both branches of congress, and to the senators
14 and representatives in congress from this commonwealth.
