## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Brockton to make an Additional Surface Drainage Loan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Brockton, for surface drainage  
2 purposes, may issue from time to time, outside the  
3 statutory limit of indebtedness, bonds or notes to an  
4 amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars in  
5 addition to the amounts already authorized. Such bonds  
6 or notes shall be denominated on their face, Brockton  
7 Surface Drainage Loan, Act of 1920, and shall bear in-  
8 terest at such rate as may be fixed by the city treasurer,  
9 with the approval of the mayor. They shall be issued  
10 in compliance with the requirements of chapter seven  
11 hundred and nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred  
12 and thirteen, and the amendments thereof. Each au-  
13 thorized issue of such bonds or notes shall constitute a  
14 separate loan, and any premiums received therefrom shall  
15 be used as provided by general law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
