To accompany the petition of the Metropolitan Park Employees Union No. 100, by J. J. Shea, president, for an increase in the compensation of certain employees of the Metropolitan District Commission. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To establish the Compensation of Certain Persons employed by the Metropolitan District Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The compensation of all persons
2 in the employ of the metropolitan district com-
3 mission, whose annual compensation does not
4 exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars, shall
5 receive an increase in such compensation equal to
6 thirty per cent of their present compensation.

1 SECTION 2. All persons in said employ whose
2 annual compensation exceeds twelve hundred
3 dollars, but does not exceed two thousand dollars,

4 shall receive an increase in such compensation
5 equal to seventeen and one-half per cent of their
6 present compensation.

1 SECTION 3. Engineers, firemen and oilers in
2 said employ shall receive the same rate of
3 compensation paid for the same service in private
4 employment governed by the union scale of
5 wages.
