In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To reimburse the W. H. Ellis and Son Company for Losses unavoidably sustained in performing a State Contract.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There may be allowed and paid from the treas-
2 ury of the commonwealth to W. H. Ellis and
3 Son Company the sum of dollars,
4 to reimburse said company for extra expenditures
5 necessarily undertaken and incurred by it in con-
6 sequence of extraordinary and unforeseen con-
7 ditions in performing its contract with the com-
8 monwealth for the erection of the New Bedford
9 state pier.
