## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Installation, Alteration and Inspection of Elevators and to the Appointment of a Board of Elevator Regulations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter eight hun-  
2 dred and six of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 thirteen is hereby amended by striking out in the  
4 third line thereof the words, "at intervals of not  
5 more than one year, and", and in the fourth line  
6 thereof the word "other", — so as to read as  
7 follows: — *Section 3.* All elevators shall be  
8 thoroughly inspected and a practical test made  
9 of the safety devices required therefor at such  
10 times as may be deemed necessary by the in-

11 spector having jurisdiction thereof. Within ten  
12 days after the inspection, the inspector shall  
13 report the result thereof to the chief of the district  
14 police, upon forms to be furnished by him. This  
15 requirement for the making of inspection reports  
16 shall not apply to the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
