AN ACT

To place Local Moth Superintendents in Cities under the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In cities that accept this act as
2 provided in section two, the office of local super-
3 intendent for the suppression of gypsy and brown
4 tail moths, established under section four of
5 chapter three hundred and eighty-one of the
6 acts of nineteen hundred and five and amend-
7 ments thereof, shall be subject to the civil service
8 laws and rules, and the laws relating to the re-
9 moval, suspension or reduction of persons in
10 the classified civil service shall apply thereto:

11 *provided*, that no person holding such office at
12 the time this act takes effect in any city shall be
13 required to submit to a civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not take effect in
2 any city unless it is accepted by vote of the city
3 council, or other governing body thereof, with
4 the approval of the mayor.
