

SENATE No. 511

To accompany the petition of Charles S. Ashley, mayor, that the city of New Bedford may be authorized to fix the rate of compensation of any veteran retired from the service of said city. Cities.

AN ACT

Relative to the Rate of Compensation to be paid to Civil War Veterans in the Employ of New Bedford, retired under Chapter Five Hundred and Four of the Acts of Nineteen Hundred and Eleven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city council of the city of
2 New Bedford, with the consent of the mayor,
3 may fix the rate of compensation of any veteran
4 of the Civil war, who has been retired from em-
5 ployment by the said city under chapter five
6 hundred and four of the acts of nineteen hun-
7 dred and eleven at three fourths of the rate of
8 compensation paid to him at the time of his
9 retirement; and in all future retirements under

10 said chapter five hundred and four of the acts of
11 nineteen hundred and eleven the rate of com-
12 pensation may be fixed at three fourths of the
13 rate of compensation paid at the time of retire-
14 ment, if so fixed by the city council of New
15 Bedford, with the consent of the mayor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
