AN ACT

To prohibit the Taking Part in Sports and Games during
Certain Hours on Memorial Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto
- 3 to be known as section twenty-nine, as follows: — *Section*
- 4 *29.* It shall be unlawful to take part in or witness any
- 5 athletic sport or game on the thirtieth day of May, or the
- 6 day following, if said day occurs on Sunday, between the
- 7 hours of eight in the forenoon and one in the afternoon.
- 8 Any person violating any provision of this section shall be
- 9 punished by a fine of ten dollars.
