Accompanying the petition of the mayor, board of aldermen and others of the city of Chelsea that said city be authorized to retire Patrick J. Gaffney, attendance officer in the public schools. Cities. January 12.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Chelsea to retire Patrick J. Gaffney, Attendance Officer in the Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Chelsea may retire, at his own
2 request, Patrick J. Gaffney, attendance officer in the
3 public schools of Chelsea, after he has served thirty
4 years as an employee of the city, or before such time
5 in case he becomes incapacitated, on an annual pension
6 equal to one half the compensation at the time of
7 retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by vote of the city council of the said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, provided that
4 such acceptance occurs prior to the thirty-first day of
5 December in the current year.
