

HOUSE No. 480

Accompanying the petition of Harvey E. Frost for an extension of the age of retirement for employees of the Commonwealth. Social Welfare. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

To extend the Age of Retirement for Employees of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (2) of section two of chapter
2 thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in line thirteen, the word "seventy", and
4 inserting in place thereof the word:— seventy-five,—so
5 that said paragraph as amended will read as follows:—
6 (2) All persons who are members of the teachers' re-
7 tirement association at the time of entering the service of
8 the commonwealth, and persons who were or are in the
9 employment of a department or institution formerly ad-
10 ministered by a city, county or corporation when taken
11 over by the commonwealth shall become members of the
12 association, irrespective of age, but no such person shall

13 remain in the service of the commonwealth after reaching
14 the age of seventy-five. Except as provided in paragraph
15 (3) all other persons who enter the service of the com-
16 monwealth hereafter shall, upon completing ninety days
17 of service, become thereby members of the association,
18 except that such persons over fifty-five shall not be
19 allowed to become members of the association, and no
20 such person shall remain in the service of the common-
21 wealth after reaching the age of seventy-five.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of January nineteen hundred and twenty-one.
