AN ACT

To extend the Law Relative to Identification of Criminals by the Finger-print System.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and ninety-three of the acts of
2 the year nineteen hundred and six is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in the first line, the words "Whenever the",
4 and inserting in place thereof the word: — Any, — and
5 by striking out, in the second, third and fourth lines, all
6 after the word "detention", to and including the word
7 "officer", in the fourth line, and by striking out the
8 second sentence of the act.
