To prohibit Fishing in Great Ponds during the Months of
October, November and December.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives

2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following:— No person shall fish in
4 any Great Pond in the commonwealth during the months
5 of October, November and December.
