AN ACT

Relative to the Payment of an Annuity to the Widow of
Thomas M. Butler.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 There shall be annually appropriated and paid out of
2 the treasury of the commonwealth the sum of five hun-
3 dred dollars as an annuity to Bridget M. Butler, widow
4 of Thomas M. Butler, a former employee of the com-
5 monwealth, the same to continue until her youngest child
6 reaches the age of twenty-one, unless she previously
7 remarries.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, February 22, 1906.
