

HOUSE No. 690

Accompanying the petition of George W. Pratt and another relative to the operation and maintenance of the Norfolk County Agricultural School. Agriculture. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

Relative to the Operation and Maintenance of the Norfolk County Agricultural School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The greater part or the total expense of
2 the operation and maintenance of the Norfolk county
3 agricultural school at Walpole shall hereafter be borne
4 by the commonwealth of Massachusetts; or the said
5 school may be discontinued.

1 SECTION 2. The management of said school shall be
2 vested in a board of trustees to be selected by the
3 governor from residents of Norfolk county, none of
4 whom shall be an incumbent of any other county office.
5 Said trustees shall be appointed as follows:— Two for

6 four years; two for three years; two for two years;
7 and one for one year; and as the terms of office expire
8 the appointments shall be for four years.

1 SECTION 3. Every student graduating from said
2 school, or receiving tuition thereat, shall be required to
3 follow some agricultural, or similar vocation within said
4 county or the state for a space of three years after
5 leaving said school.

1 SECTION 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
