

HOUSE No. 743

Accompanying the petition of Ellerton James for legislation to establish the size of a cord of sawed wood. Mercantile Affairs. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

To establish the Size of a Cord of Sawed Wood.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That a cord of one cut wood (that is
2 sticks two feet in length) shall when piled up measure
3 one hundred and ten cubic feet; that a cord of two cut
4 wood (that is sticks sixteen inches in length) shall con-
5 tain when stacked one hundred and six cubic feet; and
6 that a cord of three cut wood (that is sticks one foot
7 long) shall contain when piled one hundred and one cubic
8 feet.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
