### AN ACT

To exempt Veterans of the World War from the War Poll Tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter six hundred and eight of the  
2 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty is hereby amended  
3 by inserting after the word "insurrection", in the second  
4 line thereof the words: — or of the world war, — so as to  
5 read as follows: — *Section 1.* Any honorably discharged  
6 veteran of the Spanish war, of the Philippine insurrection  
7 or of the World war, shall, upon application in writing  
8 to the board of assessors of the city or town in which he  
9 resides, receive an abatement of any war poll tax as-  
10 sessed upon him under the provisions of chapter two  
11 hundred and eighty-three of the General Acts of nineteen  
12 hundred and nineteen.
