

HOUSE No. 966

Accompanying the petition of Raymond E. Hinxman for an amendment of the law to regulate bakeries and bakery products. Public Health. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

Relative to Bakeries and Bakery Products.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter four hundred and eighteen is hereby amended
2 in line six by the striking out of the word "and", after
3 the word seven, and the addition of the words:— and
4 twenty, after the word eight, — so that section one shall
5 read as follows: — *Section 1.* The word bakery is defined,
6 for the purposes of this act, as a building or part of a
7 building wherein is carried on the production, preparation,
8 packing, storing, display or sale of bread, cake, pies or
9 other bakery products, including any separate room or
10 rooms used for the convenience or accommodation of the
11 workers: *provided*, that sections three, four, six, seven,
12 eight and twenty shall not apply to retail stores where
13 bakery products are sold, but not produced.
