Accompanying the petition of Edward T. Esty that the Trustees of Amherst College be authorized to hold additional property. Education. January 24.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

To authorize Amherst College to hold Additional Property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of Amherst college, for the
2 purpose set forth in the act establishing said college,
3 being chapter eighty-four of the acts of the year eight-
4 een hundred and twenty-four and in the several acts
5 in addition thereto, are hereby authorized to acquire by
6 gift, grant, bequest, devise or otherwise, any lands, tene-
7 ments or other estate, real or personal, and to hold,
8 manage, and from time to time to invest and re-invest
9 the same, or the proceeds of any sale thereof, for the
10 purposes aforesaid: *provided*, that the net annual income
11 of all the property so held shall not exceed the sum of one
12 million dollars.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
