AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to Pay a Sum of Money to
Thomas F. Goode.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay to Thomas F. Goode the sum of five thousand
3 dollars for injuries received by him while assisting a police
4 officer in the performance of his duty.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the city council of said city, in accordance with
3 the provisions of its charter, provided that such accept-
4 ance occurs prior to December thirty-first in the current
5 year.
