### RESOLVE

To provide for the Erection of a Suitable Memorial in the State House to commemorate the Service of Chaplains William F. Davitt and Simon A. O'Rourke.

1 *Resolved*, That a commission consisting of two members  
2 of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker,  
3 two members of the Senate, appointed by the president  
4 of the senate, and two persons appointed by the governor,  
5 shall be a commission to provide for the erection within  
6 the state house of a suitable memorial tablet in bronze to  
7 commemorate the heroic and humane service of the  
8 Reverend William F. Davitt, chaplain of the thirty-  
9 second division of the one hundred and twenty-fifth  
10 infantry of the United States army, and Reverend Simon  
11 A. O'Rourke, chaplain lieutenant, United States navy, and  
12 other chaplains. The members of the said commission  
13 shall serve without pay, but shall be allowed from the  
14 treasury of the commonwealth the sum of  
15 dollars to defray the expenses of erecting such tablet.
