### AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Mental Diseases to take Land in Belchertown for the Belchertown State School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of mental diseases is hereby author-  
2 ized, with the approval of the governor and council, to  
3 purchase or take in fee in behalf of the commonwealth  
4 land in the town of Belchertown to be used for the Bel-  
5 chertown state school. The department shall have the  
6 same powers to acquire land under this act which are  
7 given to the metropolitan park commission by section  
8 thirty-three, chapter ninety-two, General Laws, and any  
9 person aggrieved by determination of damages made by  
10 the department may have the same assessed by a jury of  
11 the superior court in the manner and subject to the limi-  
12 tations specified in said chapter ninety-two.

Approved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America on July 11, 1890.
