AN ACT

To make the Birthday of Abraham Lincoln a Legal Holiday.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter four of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "first", in
3 line forty-six, the words:— February twelfth; and in
4 line forty-nine by striking out the word "five", and in-
5 serting in place thereof the word:— six, — so as to read:
6 — Eighteenth, "Legal holiday" shall include January
7 first, February twelfth, February twenty-second, April
8 nineteenth, May thirtieth, July fourth, the first Monday
9 of September, October twelfth, Thanksgiving day and
10 Christmas day, or the day following when any of the six
11 days first mentioned, October twelfth or Christmas day
12 occurs on Sunday; and the public offices shall be closed
13 on all of said days.
