### AN ACT

To provide a Penalty for Certain Violations of the Laws relative to the Observance of the Lord's Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the General  
2 Laws of Massachusetts is hereby amended by adding  
3 after section twenty-four the following new section:—  
4 *Section 24A.* The penalties provided in sections two and  
5 three of this chapter shall apply to all acts done in viola-  
6 tion of the provisions of sections twenty-one to twenty-  
7 four inclusive.
