### AN ACT

Relatives to Payments by County Treasurers for Services  
of County Employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A county treasurer upon receiving notice  
2 from the proper authority that a person has been ap-  
3 pointed or designated to a particular position in the  
4 service of the county, and a stipulated amount of salary  
5 for such person has been certified by said authority, it  
6 shall be the duty of the treasurer to pay such salary  
7 without requiring a bill to be rendered for such services.

1 SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of a county treasurer  
2 to pay any county employee weekly, bi-monthly or  
3 monthly as such employee may elect.

1 SECTION 3. A county employee may upon written  
2 request to the county treasurer draw his vacation pay  
3 in advance.

1 SECTION 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with  
2 the three preceding sections are hereby repealed.
