Accompanying the petition of James J. Kaplan that the corporate powers of the T. H. Jones Shoe Company be revived. Mercantile Affairs. January 27.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two.

AN ACT

To revive the Corporation known as the T. H. Jones Shoe Company.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 cause great inconvenience and expense, therefore it is
3 hereby declared to be an emergency law necessary for
4 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The T. H. Jones Shoe Company, a corporation, dis-
2 solved by chapter one hundred and eleven of the Special
3 Acts of the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby
4 revived with the same powers, duties and obligations as
5 if the said chapter had not been passed.
