AN ACT

Authorizing the Town of Saugus to pay a Pension to Justin E. Mansfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Saugus may retire Justin E.
2 Mansfield, for twenty-eight years janitor of its town hall,
3 on a pension not exceeding seven hundred and thirty
4 dollars a year, to be paid in equal weekly instalments
5 so long as he shall live.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters
2 of the town of Saugus for their acceptance at the next
3 annual town meeting on the official ballot used for the
4 election of town officers, in the form of the following
5 question:—“Shall an act passed by the general court
6 in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-two entitled
7 ‘An Act authorizing the town of Saugus to pay a pension
8 to Justin E. Mansfield’ be accepted?” If a majority
9 of the voters voting thereon vote in the affirmative then
10 this act shall take effect.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of authorizing its sub-
2 mission to the voters of said town, this act shall take
3 effect on its passage.
