AN ACT

Authorizing the Town of Cohasset to vote to revoke its Acceptance of the Civil Service Laws as Applicable to its Police Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Cohasset may vote to re-
2 voke its acceptance of the provisions of the civil service
3 laws applicable to its police department. If the town
4 votes to revoke such acceptance, then the members of
5 the police department of said town shall not continue to
6 hold office under civil service or the rules and regulations
7 made thereunder. Nothing herein contained shall pre-
8 vent the town from hereafter accepting the provisions of
9 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws applicable to its
10 police department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
