

HOUSE No. 1720

Accompanying the petition of Edward C. Hinekley for legislation relative to the Barnstable County Retirement Association and relative to the rights and obligations of county employees therein. Counties. May. 23.

AN ACT

Relative to the Barnstable County Retirement Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The employees of Barnstable county shall
2 be deemed to have become members of the Barnstable
3 County Retirement Association established under the
4 provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, or
5 the corresponding provisions of earlier statutes upon its
6 organization, and shall be exempt from the making of
7 deposits to the annuity and pension fund of said asso-
8 ciation required by the provisions of section twenty-four
9 of said chapter for any period prior to the date of such
10 organization.

1 SECTION 2. Said employees shall otherwise be subject
2 to all the provisions of said chapter thirty-two applicable
3 to said association and the benefits payable to such em-
4 ployees under the provisions of section twenty-five of said
5 chapter shall be based on the deposits made by said em-
6 ployees from and after date of said organization.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
