Accompanying the recommendations of the Board of Dental Examiners (see House, No. 61). Public Service. January 3.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

Establishing the Salary of the Secretary of the Board of Dental Examiners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirteen of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section twenty-one and inserting
3 in place thereof the following:— *Section 21.* There shall
4 be paid by the commonwealth to the chairman of the
5 board a salary of eight hundred dollars, to the secretary
6 of the board a salary of fifteen hundred dollars, to the
7 other members thereof six hundred dollars each, and to
8 each member thereof his necessary traveling expenses
9 actually incurred in attending meetings of the board.
10 The board shall keep a record of all money received and
11 expenses incurred by it, and a duplicate thereof shall be
12 open to public inspection in the office of the state auditor.
