Accompanying the petition of Francis J. Finneran relative to the taxation in the city of Boston of certain non-residents. Taxation. January 12.

AN ACT

Relative to the Taxation in the City of Boston of Certain Non-residents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Male persons of the age of twenty-one or
2 over who have a place of business or who are employed
3 in the city of Boston but whose legal residence is else-
4 where shall be subject to a tax of two dollars a year to
5 be paid and collected in the same manner as poll taxes,
6 and the penalty for non-payment of the same shall be
7 the same as that for non-payment of poll taxes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
