## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

### AN ACT

Authorizing the City of Lawrence to incur Indebtedness for Permanent Pavement Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of completing the con-  
2 struction of granite block pavement on South Broadway  
3 from Andover street to the boundary line of the town of  
4 Andover, the city of Lawrence may from time to time  
5 borrow such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding  
6 in the aggregate eighty thousand dollars, and may issue  
7 bonds or notes therefor which shall bear on their face  
8 the words, "Lawrence Pavement Loan, Acts of 1923".  
9 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan.  
10 Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess  
11 of the statutory limit, but shall, except as herein pro-  
12 vided, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General  
13 Laws and amendments thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
