The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

To direct City and Town Clerks to send Information relative to the Boards of Registrars and Precinct Officers to the Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one hundred and thirty-two of chapter fifty-
2 four of the General Laws, as amended by section six,
3 chapter two hundred and ninety of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-one, is hereby further amended by
5 adding at the end thereof the words:—The city or
6 town clerk shall, within fifteen days after a biennial state
7 election, certify to the state secretary the names, and
8 party enrolment, if any, of the board of registrars, and
9 the names, and party enrolment, if any, of the precinct
10 officers employed in each voting precinct or town on said
11 biennial election day, and this information shall be open
12 to public inspection.
