## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

### AN ACT

Authorizing the Trustees of the Essex County Agricultural School to make Certain Improvements at Said School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of the Essex county agri-  
2 cultural school, may, subject to the approval of the de-  
3 partment of education, expend a sum not exceeding  
4 twenty thousand dollars, to be provided by the county of  
5 Essex, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a  
6 greenhouse, including the head house.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the county  
2 commissioners of said county may from time to time  
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may  
4 be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, twenty  
5 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the  
6 county therefor. Each authorized issue shall constitute a  
7 separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not  
8 more than five years from their dates. Such bonds or  
9 notes shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and  
10 countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners.  
11 The county may sell the said securities at public or  
12 private sale upon such terms and conditions as the

13 county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less  
14 than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder  
15 shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter  
16 thirty-five of the General Laws. The proceeds from the  
17 sale of the bonds or notes issued hereunder shall be paid  
18 to the trustees of said school by the treasurer of the  
19 county upon their requisition.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-  
2 ceptance by the county commissioners of Essex county;  
3 provided, that such acceptance occurs prior to December  
4 thirty-first in the current year.
