Accompanying the petition of the town of Falmouth that said town be authorized to raise money for a special celebration on Memorial Day in the current year. Towns. April 30.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Town of Falmouth to raise and appropriate Money for a Special Celebration on Memorial Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of having a special public
2 celebration on memorial day in the current year in the
3 town of Falmouth on the occasion of publicly awarding
4 the Distinguished Service Cross to Cornelius P. Collins, a
5 veteran of the world war, said town is hereby authorized
6 to raise and appropriate, or to use from any available
7 funds, a sum of money not to exceed two thousand five
8 hundred dollars, provided it is so voted at a town
9 meeting held therefor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
