In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

RESOLVE

Granting an Annuity to Nancy E. Turner of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That there be paid annually from the
2 treasury of the commonwealth, in quarterly install-
3 ments, from January first, nineteen hundred and
4 twenty-four, the sum of one hundred and fifty
5 dollars to Nancy E. Turner of Boston, a descendant
6 of the Mashpee tribe of Indians. Said annuity shall
7 continue during her life. The first payment under
8 authority of this resolve shall not be made until
9 an appropriation is made sufficient to cover the
10 same.
