In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act regulating the Power of the Commissioner of Correction to remove Prisoners from County Penal Institutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after
3 section one hundred and thirteen, the following
4 new section:—

5 *Section 113A.* The power to remove a prisoner
6 from a jail or house of correction conferred upon
7 the commissioner by any provision of this chapter
8 shall be exercised only with the approval of the
9 sheriff of the county maintaining such jail or house
10 of correction.
