By Mr. Edward J. Kelley of Worcester, petition of Edward J. Kelley that the Department of Education be directed to establish a state normal school in the city of Worcester. Education. Jan. 14, 1924.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act to provide for the Establishment of a State Normal School in the City of Worcester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of education is hereby directed to
2 acquire by eminent domain on behalf of the common-
3 wealth under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine of
4 the General Laws a suitable site for the construction of
5 a state normal school in the city of Worcester and may
6 expend for such purpose such sum not exceeding
7 dollars as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
