An Act to provide for the Construction of a Certain Underpass and Fence on Lowell Street in the Town of Lexington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby directed to  
2 construct an underpass and fence and such other fixtures  
3 and improvements as may be necessary on Lowell street  
4 in the town of Lexington to comply with the conditions  
5 imposed by a deed from one Frank H. Reed to the town  
6 of Lexington and may expend such sum not exceeding  
7    dollars as may hereafter be appropri-  
8 ated therefor.
