## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act authorizing the Registration of Alexander R. Prudent  
as a Chiropodist.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of registration in medicine is hereby author-  
2 ized to register Alexander R. Prudent as a chiropodist,  
3 without examination, upon satisfactory proof that he has  
4 been engaged in the practice of chiropody in this common-  
5 wealth during the period nineteen hundred and six to  
6 nineteen hundred and thirteen, inclusive, this being prior  
7 to the passage of chapter fifteen of the General Acts of  
8 nineteen hundred and eighteen, and without proof of  
9 further compliance with chapter one hundred and twelve  
10 of the General Laws; and thereupon he shall have and  
11 enjoy the same rights and privileges as if registered as a  
12 chiropodist as provided by said chapter one hundred and  
13 twelve.
