

HOUSE No. 745

By Mr. Hull of Leominster, petition of Everett W. Coleman that the Board of Registration in Optometry be authorized to register Fred C. Goodwill as an optometrist. Public Health. Jan. 14, 1924.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act authorizing the Registration of Fred C. Goodwill as an Optometrist.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The board of registration in optometry is hereby
2 authorized to register Fred C. Goodwill of Orange as an
3 optometrist, without examination, upon satisfactory proof
4 that he has been engaged in the practice of optometry in
5 this commonwealth for a period of two years next prior
6 to the passage of chapter seven hundred of the General
7 Acts of nineteen hundred and twelve, and without proof
8 of further compliance with chapter one hundred and
9 twelve of the General Laws; and thereupon he shall have
10 and enjoy the same rights and privileges as if registered
11 as an optometrist as provided by said chapter one hundred
12 and twelve.
