Cutting and others, county commissioners, that the county of Middlesex be authorized to make further expenditure in the alteration of county buildings in Cambridge, report the accompanying bill (new draft).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

An Act to provide for Further Expenditure by the County of Middlesex on Account of Alterations of County Buildings at Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes specified in chapter
2 three hundred and nine of the acts of nineteen hundred
3 and twenty-one and in chapter two hundred and thirty-
4 five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-
5 three, the county commissioners of the county of Middle-
6 sex may from time to time borrow upon the credit of the
7 county such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding
8 in the aggregate, fifty thousand dollars, and may issue
9 bonds or notes of the county therefor. Each authorized
10 issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans
11 shall be payable in not more than twenty years from
12 their dates. Such bonds or notes shall be signed by the
13 treasurer of the county and countersigned by a majority
14 of the county commissioners. The county may sell the
15 said securities at public or private sale upon such terms
16 and conditions as the county commissioners may deem
17 proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebted-
18 ness incurred hereunder shall be subject to chapter
19 thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the county commissioners of Middlesex
3 county; provided, that such acceptance occurs prior to
4 December thirty-first of the current year.
