## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act to enable Owners of Rights, Titles and Interests in or to Lots, Tombs or Monuments, owned or controlled by any Company, Association or Corporation, to Sell and Convey the Same.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The owner of any right, title or interest in or to a lot,  
2 tomb or monument owned or controlled by any company,  
3 association or corporation, may sell and convey any part  
4 or all of said right, title or interest to any person or  
5 persons who could purchase, in their own right, similar  
6 rights, titles and interests from such company, associa-  
7 tion, corporation or cemetery organization.
