Mr. Beck of Chelsea presented a petition of John E. Beck that the city of Chelsea be authorized to pension Chester B. Flanders. Cities. Jan. 28, 1924.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act authorizing the City of Chelsea to pension
Chester B. Flanders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Chelsea may retire Ches-
2 ter B. Flanders, for twenty-seven years a member of
3 the permanent fire force of said city, on an annual
4 pension equal to two thirds the annual salary re-
5 ceived by him at the time of such retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter; provided,
4 that such acceptance occurs prior to December
5 thirty-first in the current year.
