## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act to permit the Inspection and Acceptance of  
Steam Boilers for Power and Heating.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. That steam boilers constructed of  
2 steel with headers, flanges, nozzles, or other appur-  
3 tenances, of cast iron or steel, that may be in this  
4 commonwealth since nineteen hundred and eight, or  
5 may hereafter be brought into the commonwealth,  
6 may be inspected and a certificate issued to operate  
7 the same under the same conditions as are provided  
8 for boilers that were in this commonwealth at the  
9 time of the passage of chapter four hundred and  
10 sixty-five, and all amendments thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
