Resolve providing for the Appointment of a Special Commission to study and examine into the Matter of the Disposal of Garbage, Waste and Other Refuse.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health shall
2 study and examine into the matter of the disposal of
3 garbage, waste and other refuse throughout the common-
4 wealth, with particular reference to the methods and
5 manner of disposing of garbage so that the same will not
6 constitute a public or private nuisance or be obnoxious.
7 The department may expend for expert, clerical and other
8 assistance and for other expenses, such sums, not ex-
9 ceeding in the aggregate ten thousand dollars, as may
10 be approved by the governor and council. Said depart-
11 ment shall file with the general court not later than the
12 second Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and
13 twenty-five, a report of its findings and recommenda-
14 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation embody-
15 ing any such recommendations.
