Resolve providing for the Establishment of a Special Commission for the Examination and Revision of the Laws relating to Credit Unions.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission be estab-
2 lished to consist of two senators to be designated
3 by the president of the senate, and three represent-
4 atives to be designated by the speaker of the house
5 of representatives, the commissioner of banks, and
6 three other persons to be appointed by the gov-
7 ernor, for the purpose of examining and revising
8 the laws relating to credit unions. The commission
9 may expend for clerical and other assistance such
10 sums as may be approved by the governor and coun-
11 cil, and shall report with its recommendations and
12 drafts of legislation embodying the same, to the
13 General court not later than the second Wednesday
14 in January in the year nineteen hundred and
15 twenty-five.
