HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, April 9, 1924.

The Committee on State House, who were directed by an order of the two branches to report, as required by the provisions of section 15 of chapter 8 of the General Laws, what repairs and improvements are necessary upon the State House and grounds connected therewith, —

Report that, by the operation of the budget system under the present law, all matters relating to repairs and improvements in the State House are referred directly to the House Committee on Ways and Means, and not to the Joint Committee on State House, as provided under said section; and therefore this committee recommends that said statute be repealed. To accomplish this purpose the necessary bill will be introduced.
