Resolve directing the Metropolitan District Commission to Investigate the Question of Establishing a Route or Routes connecting the Lynn Woods with the Newburyport Turnpike.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby directed to investigate a route or routes for a
3 parkway from the proposed Lynn Fells parkway at Wal-
4 nut street, North Saugus, through Lynn woods, and the
5 cost of constructing the same. The commission shall file
6 a report, including its estimate of the cost of the work
7 and a plan of the route recommended, on or before the
8 fifteenth day of December of the current year, and at
9 the same time shall file a copy of the same with the
10 budget commissioner as a part of the budget estimates
11 required to be submitted under section twenty-four of
12 chapter twenty-nine of the General Laws.

13 For the purposes of this resolve the commission may
14 expend such sum from the metropolitan parks mainte-
15 nance fund, not exceeding five hundred dollars, as may
16 hereafter be appropriated.
