Mr. Hutt of Southborough presented a petition of Albert E. Hutt for the validation of certain acts of the officers of the Fayville Fire and Water District and clarifying the provisions of law relative to their term of office. Towns. May 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

An Act validating the Acts of the Officers of the Fayville Fire and Water District and clarifying the Provisions of Law relative to their Term of Office.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The election of the commissioners of the
2 Fayville fire and water district elected at the meeting
3 held on October eight, nineteen hundred and twenty-
4 three, and all acts of such commissioners done in pur-
5 suance thereof are hereby validated and confirmed, and
6 the said district shall, at its annual meeting of nineteen
7 hundred and twenty-four, elect by ballot a board of com-
8 missioners consisting of three persons to hold office, one
9 for three years, one for two years, and one for one year,
10 and at each annual meeting thereafter the said district
11 shall elect officers in the manner provided in section nine
12 of chapter four hundred and seventy-four of the acts of
13 nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
