## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

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An Act Incorporating The Trustees of the Fletcher Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

3 W. Stott, George H. Staples, Edith H. Ray, Orestes T.  
4 Doe, George F. S. Singleton, Harry T. Hayward, Charles  
5 A. Whiting, all of Franklin, and Catherine J. Fallett of  
6 Wrentham, in the commonwealth of Massachusetts, and  
7 their successors, are hereby made a body corporate by  
8 the name of The Trustees of the Fletcher Hospital, for  
9 the purpose of constructing and maintaining a hospital  
10 in the town of Franklin in said commonwealth, and for  
11 the purpose of receiving, holding and expending such  
12 sums as may be received by them from the estate of  
13 Austin B. Fletcher, late of New York in the state of  
14 New York, and such other devises, bequests or contri-  
15 butions from outside sources for the aforesaid purposes;  
16 and with all the duties, powers and privileges imposed  
17 or conferred upon corporations of like character. The  
18 successor to any member of said corporation shall be  
19 named by the remaining members thereof.
